Facts & FAQs

- For the purposes of this grant, an event is a single-or multi-day gathering typically organized and staged by a local organization or business. The event is centered on celebrating some unique aspect of the community, the services of an agency, a historic person or milestone, culture or tradition, or local/national holiday. Events showing the greater ability to attract visitors from 50+ miles (one-way) outside of Appanoose County and encourage overnight hotel stays will have the better success at being funded.
- For the purposes of this grant, a tourist attraction is a physical or cultural feature at a place that individual travelers or visitors experience for their specific leisure-related interests. These attractions typically offer natural or cultural value, historical significance, or natural or formed beauty, offering amusement, leisure, adventure, or educational value. A tourism attraction must show the ability to attract visitors from 50+ miles (one-way) outside of Appanoose County and retain a visitor in this area for at least 3 hours.
- Funding for the Appanoose County Tourism grants comes from a portion of lodging tax funds collected in the City of Centerville and in the unincorporated areas of Appanoose County.
- The committee may award less than, but no more than the amount requested in any given grant application.
- Appanoose County Tourism grants are competitive grants and applicants will be evaluated based on a ten question rubric including criteria such as relevance, visibility, impact, quality, budget & effectiveness.
- Misrepresentation of facts or failure to comply with details outlined in the grant application may result in the reduction or withdrawal of grant funding.
- A follow-up report (Summary of Event) of any funding from the Appanoose County Tourism committee as well as images/video of the project MUST be received by November 15th 2025. If you project is not complete by the end of 2024, a status report of where the project currently stands must be submitted by November 15th 2025 to the committee to stay in good standing for future PACT/Appanoose County Tourism grant opportunities.
- If you do not submit a report or project update by November 15th 2025, your grant is in default and you will not be eligible to apply for any PACT or Appanoose County Tourism grants until your report is submitted. If you don't submit by the November 15th 2025 deadline, you will have a 30 day grace period. If you don't submit within the 30 day grace period, the organization must sit out one grant cycle before being eligible for Appanoose County Tourism grants.
